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Introduction

Trinity - what is it? This is a brief understanding. Hope it helps.

The Catholic Religions teaches the formula called the Trinity in Unity which is accepted by all Catholic priests, and some Protestant pastors. It was developed by the Church Fathers in Nicaea c 325. It describes God as three personages in one essence such that all three personages are present at the same moment. Those three personages are The Father, The Word (also called The Son) and the Holy Spirit. When one is present, then all are present.

A number of religions do not even believe in the trinity doctrine: Church of Christ, Scientist;

Jehovah's Witnesses; Oneness Pentecostals;
The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints;
and Unitarian Christians.

Here is another explanation of the Trinity:

While Christ walked with those devoted to
The Father (Apostles) in Galilee He shared the
Spirit of The Word and The Father and the
Holy Spirit one essence in continuous touch
with the divine Spirit of Jesus.

Jesus had two natures, human and divine,
and His personality was a divine personality.

Ordinary mortals have a human personality.
No matter how holy we become and even with
The Holy Spirit within us, we are still 100%
human. This is the big difference between us
and Jesus. In Jesus the Father and the Word and

The Holy Spirit were permanently resident in Jesus as He walked around Galilee. Most of the those devoted to The Father did not understand this. Even today Jews and Muslims refuse to recognize the divine nature of Jesus. According to their beliefs, Jesus was a human being, a prophet. Jews and Muslims do not believe that The Word exists. Muslims teach that Allah is the only God of the Universe, that Allah speaks for himself and needs no mouthpiece. Allah needed no helpers to make the Universe. Allah has no son.

The Holy Spirit is the glue that binds us

Think of The Holy Spirit as stretchable dough which sticks to The Father and The Son and will attach to humans if they will only grasp

for it. The dough, The Holy Spirit forms a bond between all elements of the Trinity. It manifests as the bond of love that the Father has for The Son and vice versa. Man can share this sticky bond, this love. When we receive the dough we are expected to make the bread of Jesus - and it is this bread that will sustain us as we mature towards Eternal Life. Jesus enabled people to experience The Father through Him. Jesus is the mirror image of The Father, and we can see only the reflection. We can experience The Father of

The Son following Jesus's 'Way' but we cannot see The Father 'No one has seen The Father of the Son but The Son.' We get to know The Father by 'keeping' Jesus's words. If we did this, Jesus promised that He and The Father would always be with us.

Keeping His words means to do what He said beginning with the thirty least commandments. But it is much more than those commandments. We are to study His methods and become 'wise' and 'perfect.'

What we learn from following His teaching we must guard carefully. Don't try and share your experiences with anyone other than your brethren who are also trying to follow Jesus and do the will of The Father.
